because the United Nation Organisation
wrote the Convention on Disabled People Rights.

The Convention on Disabled People Rights
is a document in which there are written
the disabled people rights.

Also Italy in 2008 has signed the Convention
on Disabled People Rights.

One of the right written in the Convention says that
all the people have the right to know all the things

they're interested in.

Before knowing things, people need to understand.

In order that all the people can understand
the association Inclusion Europe wrote
together people with disabilities
the rules to write in Easy To Read Language
are written inside a book called
“Easy To Read Guideline”.
